

Opportunities for exhibitors during the

FAO/IAEA International Symposium on Plant Mutation Breeding and Biotechnology

The IAEA is organizing the FAO/IAEA International Symposium on Plant Mutation Breeding and Biotechnology at the IAEA Headquarters in Vienna, Austria from 27 to 31 August 2018.

Approximately 500 participants from IAEA Member States and international organizations are expected to attend the conference. The IAEA is planning to hold an exhibition for commercial vendors in the fields in conjunction with the conference. A limited amount of space will be available for the vendors' displays/exhibits during the conference.

Each company will have, free of charge, an exhibition space of 6m2 (3x2m) including one table (80x160cm) and 2 chairs. Alternatively, professional booths with walls can be rented from an outside company.

Companies wishing to take advantage of this opportunity to exhibit are encouraged to make a voluntary contribution to the IAEA in support of the conference. The contribution will be used for the costs directly related to the organization of the conference. An acknowledgement of the voluntary contribution would be made in the distributed conference programme booklet given to participants upon registration.

In view of space limitations, the selection of exhibitors will be based on a 'first come first served' basis. Therefore, interested parties should contact the Scientific Secretariat by e-mail <u>ismbb2018@iaea.org</u> before **31 January 2018**.
