Marc F.P. Bierkens is the Chair in Earth Surface Hydrology at the Department of Physical Geography at Utrecht University. He received his MSc in Hydrology from Wageningen University in 1990 and his PhD in Physical Geography from Utrecht University in 1994. Marc Bierkens became Professor of Hydrology at Utrecht University in 2002. His fields of expertise are groundwater hydrology and stochastic hydrology. During the last decade he worked on global scale hydrological modelling in relation to climate change and water availability. He is also Fellow of the American Geophysical Union and editor for Water Resources Research. He was Chairman of the Boussinesg Center, the network of university hydrology groups in the Netherlands from 2007 to 2011 and Chairman of the Netherlands Hydrology Society from 2011 to 2017. Marc Bierkens has authored and co-authored about 200 publications, out of which over 150 appeared in international peer-reviewed journals. He is principal author of the book "Upscaling and Downscaling Methods for Environmental Research" (2002), co-author of the book "Sampling for Natural Resource Monitoring" (2006) and editor of the book "Climate and the Hydrological Cycle" (2008).
