Progress Prevention and Treatment

- 2006 Cervical Cancer Screening started
- 500,000 women screened for cervical cancer
- 83 centers in 10 provinces-National programme (70% of 110 districts)
- Training of Zambian Health Care Workers in Zambia cancer screening
- HPV vaccination to start in 2019
- 20 cervical cancer screening clinics were opened 2018
- 60 cervical cancer clinics are planned for 2019, breast cancer and retinoblastoma
- Cervical Cancer Support for Zambia included in the Global Fund, CDC, USAID, WORLD BANK etc
