Dr Hussein Salama is Professor of Radiology and Head of the Radiology and Radiation Protection Department at the Egyptian Atomic Energy Authority and Chief Scientific Consultant and National Representative at United Nations agencies (IAEA and WHO). She is also an international expert and lecturer, and chief scientific consultant and national counterpart for IAEA scientific activities and projects concerned with

radiology and radiation safety in medicine. Dr Hussein Salama is an acting member of the Standing Advisory Group of the DG IAEA on Technical Cooperation (SAGTAC), and a founding member of Arabsafe, Afrosafe and the international working group of the International Commission on Radiological Protection.

Dr Hussein Salama has been selected as a role model for “Women in Nuclear” at the IAEA General Conference in 2018, and as “Woman in Focus” by the European Congress of Radiology in 2019. Achievements include receiving four awards for the best research and accomplishments in radiation dose reduction, such as the Montreal Award in 2014. She has contributed to 32 publications, and supervises Masters and PhD students from different countries as well as teaches medical students at Ain Shams Faculty of Medicine.
