# Political will – Finance Secret



- The radiotherapy dream Started in 1982
- 1990's IAEA got involved
- April 2001, Proposal submitted to OFID
- August 2001 OFID approves
- 2003 Contracts for construction and equipping signed.

A Decade of Action on Cancer Control and the Way Forward 17–18 September 2019 Cancer Diseases Hospital During Construction Phase

- The government had been sending cancer patients abroad.
- At \$10 000 per patient
- Due to limited budget allocations for treatment abroad, only 350 cases out of 5,000 were sent between 1995 and 2004
- Construction started 2003

#### Minister of Finance Budget Speech

Mr. Speaker,

- Government completed the construction of a modern 252-bed capacity Cancer Diseases Hospital in June 2016.
- This facility has state of the art radiotherapy and chemotherapy services.
- In 2017, Government will commence the establishment of satellite cancer treatment centres at provincial level to complement the Cancer Diseases Hospital in Lusaka.
- Through these satellite centres, Zambians will be effectively attended to during the early stages of cancer and most importantly, avoid reaching advanced stages by the time patients are referred to Lusaka.

- 2009 Cancer EML budget allocated: grown from 400,000USD to now 3M USD

- 2013 Revised Cancer medicines part of NEML for MoH
- 2009 1<sup>ST</sup> QUATRO MISSION (IAEA)
- 2010 IMPACT MISSION (IAEA/WHO/PACT)
- 2016 Costed National Cancer Control Strategy 2017 – 2021 signed
- 2017 IAEA Calculator to cost cancer treatment
