Dr Mike Sathekge is at the forefront of specialist training and was elected President of the Colleges of Medicine of South Africa, the national specialist examining body for all medical disciplines. He is Professor and Head of the Nuclear Medicine Department at University of Pretoria. Previously, he was President of the International Society of Radiolabeled Blood Elements (ISORBE) and past Secretary General of the World Federation of Nuclear Medicine and Biology (WFNMB).

Sathekge is Chairman of the Medical Research Council of South Africa. He has performed several first-in-human studies and introduced peptide receptor radionuclide therapy and peptide radioligand therapy in Africa, as well as 225AcPSMA for prostate cancer. He is a recipient of several key awards for research and service, including being rated as an internationally acclaimed researcher by the National Research Foundation. His publication and presentation record earned him editorial roles on peer-reviewed journals. He is Co-Editor in Chief of the Seminars of Nuclear Medicine and member of the Academy of Science of South Africa (ASSAf).
