During that period, she participated in the ABACC Commission, in the Binational Cooperation Commission with Brazil (COBEN), in the Binational Enrichment Company (EBEN) and before bilateral committees of countries (Russian Federation, USA, Algeria, etc.).

Ms Maceiras has represented Argentina before the IAEA Board of Governors and General Conference, the Nuclear Suppliers Group and the Permanent Committee on Nuclear Policy with Brazil.

From 2009 to 2012 she held the position of 1st Vice President of the ARN Board of Directors.

In 2012 and 2013 she held the position of Chairman of the ARN Board of Directors.

As of September 2018, she holds the highest position in the Secretary at ABACC, for Argentina.
