PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES



With soap and water frequently for a minimum of 20 seconds



Keep at least one metre between yourself and others



As required

If you are feeling ill

- Minimise social contact with others.
- Get rest and stay hydrated.
- Take over-the-counter medication such as paracetamol to help you feel better.
- Stay home and call your doctor or the VIC Medical Service (VMS). Absence type depends on the doctor's assessment.
- Self-report to VMS, if you suspect you have COVID-19, have tested COVID positive or have been identified as a close contact.
- Come to work only if you are free of symptom(s) and healthy.
