Sean Granville, is OPG's newly appointed Chief Operations Officer and Chief Nuclear Officer as of September 2020. Sean is responsible for all of OPG's generating fleet with a capacity of over 15,400 MWe consisting of 10 nuclear units, 66 hydro stations, 2 thermal stations and a solar facility. He is also responsible for the engineering function in the company and has oversight of OPG subsidiaries Atura Power and Eagle Creek Renewable Energy.

Sean held the CNO position for just over two years, after a 2 ½ year tenure as Deputy CNO. Prior to this, Sean spent 3 years at Point Lepreau Nuclear Generating Station in New Brunswick as the Site Vice President and Chief Nuclear Officer. During his tenure, improvement was achieved as measured by the World Association of Nuclear Operators (WANO) Peer Review.

Sean's extensive background includes a 39 year career with Ontario Power Generation/Ontario Hydro holding positions such as Deputy Vice President, Director of Operations and Maintenance and Director of Nuclear Programs. He was certified as a Licenced Shift Manager and has held Duty Manager positions at Darlington and Pickering. He brings expertise in areas such as operational leadership, leader development, performance improvement, organizational effectiveness as well as industry engagement.
