Dr. Fariña Barrios is a medical doctor who graduated from the Pontificia Universidad Católica de Chile in 2001. He completed his specialization in medical radiation oncology in 2004. From 2007 to 2015, he served as Head of Teaching in Radiation Oncology at the Instituto Nacional del Cáncer, a public hospital in Chile. Since 2016, he has held the same position at FALP Cancer Center, a private institution.

At FALP, Dr. Fariña Barrios is the Director of the master's degree in advanced radiation therapy, a program supported by the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) and taught at the FALP Cancer Center in Santiago, Chile. The program focuses on updating participants' knowledge of modern cancer therapies, including IMRT, radiosurgery, SBRT, and 3D brachytherapy.
