



Mr Luis Alfredo Rovere, Vice President, Comisión Nacional de Energía Atómica (CNEA), Argentina

Luis Alfredo Rovere is a nuclear engineer and graduate of the Balseiro Institute in Argentina. He currently serves as Vice President of CNEA and leads its Department for Nuclear Applications in Health. Mr. Rovere also coordinates the Argentine Anchor Center for the IAEA's Rays of Hope initiative.

Previously, he has held key roles in nuclear research and oversight, including positions at the Reactor Controls Group, the Brazilian Argentine Agency for Accounting and Control of Nuclear Materials (ABACC), and as Head of the Bariloche Atomic Centre under the Argentine Atomic Energy Commission (CNEA).
