

Mr Manduul Enkhjargal, Nuclear Medicine physician, Nuclear Medicine Center, Second State Central Hospital of Mongolia

Mr Manduul Enkhjargal, M.D., Ph.D., is a medical doctor and nuclear medicine specialist based in Mongolia. He currently serves as a nuclear medicine physician at the Nuclear Medicine Center of the Second State Central Hospital of Mongolia. He also carries out research in oncologic imaging, and his most recent work focuses on implementing radionuclide therapy and dosimetry in resource-limited settings.

Mr Enkhjargal earned his bachelor's degree from the Mongolian National University of Medical Sciences (MNUMS) in 2013 and completed residency training in radiology in 2015. He obtained his Ph.D. in 2019 from the Department of Diagnostic Radiology and Nuclear Medicine at Gunma University in Japan. In 2022, he enrolled in a clinical fellowship in nuclear medicine at the Korea Institute of Radiological & Medical Sciences (KIRAMS).

Since 2019, Mr Enkhjargal has been working as a lecturer in the Department of Radiology at MNUMS.
