

Ms Fatima Haggar, Director, National Cancer Control Program (NCCP), Ministry of Health of Chad

Dr. Fatima A. A. Haggar, MD, MPH, PhD, is a Chadian oncologist and public health expert currently serving as the National Coordinator for the Cancer Control Program at the Ministry of Public Health in Chad. She also practices as a cancer specialist at the Hôpital de la Mère et de l'Enfant in N'Djamena.

She holds a PhD in Cancer Epidemiology from the University of Western Australia, a Master of Public Health from Curtin University, and a Bachelor's degree in Biochemistry from the University of Ottawa.

Since taking leadership of Chad's National Cancer Control Program in 2000, Dr. Haggar has led several transformative initiatives, including the creation of the N'Djamena Cancer Registry, the launch of the country's first breast and cervical cancer screening unit, the introduction of the HPV vaccine, and the development of the National Centre of Excellence in Cancer Care (CNEC) — Chad's first dedicated cancer hospital.
