

Ms Kabelo Mputsoe, Clinical Radiation Oncologist, Ministry of Health and Social Welfare of Lesotho

Ms Mputsoe graduated from the University of Malawi College of Medicine in 2007 and worked as a clinician until 2011. She acquired policy level experience while managing the NCD program and as IAEA project counterpart from 2011 to 2016, focusing on the establishment of cancer services in Lesotho.

Under sponsorship of the IAEA, she studied oncology from 2017 to 2021 and graduated as a fellow at the Zambia College of Medicine and Surgery and in Clinical Oncology at the Cancer Diseases Hospital Zambia.

During her specialization program, she set up an organized transit cancer clinic, which is now called the Senkatana Oncology Clinic. Chemotherapy was administered in Lesotho in July 2022 and the inpatient ward opened in December 2022 for long infusions.
