



Statement by the Republic of Liberia

68th Regular Session of the IAEA General Conference Vienna, Austria

Mr. President, Honorable Director General, Excellencies, and Distinguished Delegates; it is an honor to address this 69th General Conference of the International Atomic Energy Agency on behalf of the government and people of the Republic of Liberia.

We congratulate you, Mr. President, on your election and assure you of Liberia's full support. We commend Director General Rafael Mariano Grossi for his outstanding leadership and thank him for his historic visit to Liberia earlier this year—the first of its kind in the history of the IAEA.

During his visit, Liberia received a mammography machine, which will greatly enhance our cancer screening and early detection capabilities. The DG and the President of Liberia also broke ground for the construction of a radiotherapy center, which will enable





us diagnose and treat cancer patients not just from Liberia but also from the Mano River Union Countries. We express profound gratitude for these donations.

The IAEA's work in promoting peaceful nuclear energy and supporting sustainable development is invaluable. We applaud the Agency's use of nuclear science and technology in improving food security and cancer treatment, areas where Liberia has benefited.

Liberia remains committed to implementing its Country Programme Framework and acknowledges the Technical Cooperation Programme's role in advancing national development priorities. We look forward to deepening our collaboration with the Agency in health, agriculture, water resources, and energy.

We reaffirm our commitment to nuclear safety, security, and safeguards, ensuring nuclear science and technology serve peaceful purposes.

Liberia thanks the Director General and Secretariat for their continued support and stands ready to work with Member States to advance the Agency's objectives.
