

He is currently Director of Scientific Studies and Research at the National Centre for Nuclear Energy, Science and Technology (CNESTEN), overseeing 5 Divisions and 14 Scientific Units. His work focuses on applying nuclear and isotopic techniques to water resources, agriculture, and the marine environment. He has published over 90 scientific articles and coordinated more than 10 IAEA-supported projects, including major regional initiatives in Africa. He is widely recognized for advancing the use of nuclear techniques to address key sustainable development challenges.
