Ms Anne-Isabelle Étienvre is the Chairman of the French Alternative Energies and Atomic Energy Commission (CEA), appointed by the Council of Ministers in July 2025. A physicist by training with a PhD in particle physics, she began her career as a researcher, including at CERN, before joining the CEA in 2003. She later served as Director of the Department of Particle Physics, Director of the Institute for Research on the Fundamental Laws of the Universe (Irfu) and Director of Fundamental Research. She has also advised the French Minister of Higher Education and Research and coordinated the Laboratory of Excellence P2IO.
