## Poland: draft resolution

#### The General Conference,

Being convinced that in order to fulfil the tasks allotted to it, the Agency must establish its activity on sound scientific and technical bases;

Being also convinced that this aim can only be achieved if the Agency makes use of the total knowledge and experience accumulated by the various scientific research centres concerned with the peaceful uses of atomic energy;

1. Decides to utilize, for its work, all these sources of knowledge and experience;

2. <u>Recommends</u> the Board of Governors and the Director General to invite the participation of the above-mentioned persons and institutions, should the fulfilment of the tasks of the Agency require scientific work and rosearch;

3. <u>Expresses</u> its gratitude to the Members of the Agency who have already offered assistance in that field, and urgently requests the other Nembers who can do so, to offer their assistance.

## Appendix 2

#### TRAINING OF SPECIALISTS IN THE USE OF ISOTOPES IN AGRICULTURE AND MEDICINE

#### Poland: draft resolution

### The General Conference,

<u>Bearing in mind</u> that the use of isotopes is of great importance in the development of agriculture and modicine,

<u>Bearing in mind</u> that the practical use of isotopes requires a large number of well trained specialists and that the majority of countries do not possess enough for this purpose,

<u>Recommends</u> the Board of Governors and the Director General to co-operate in accordance with paragraphs 32 and 41 of the Agency's initial programme with the Food and Igriculture Organization of the United Nations, the World Health Organization and scientific contres engaged in such research which already have practical experience of the use of isotopes in agriculture and medicine, with a view to the organization in such centres of appropriate courses for Member States of the Agency, special attention being paid to the needs of under-developed countries.
