ADOPTION OF THE AGENDA AND ALLOCATION OF ITELS FOR INITIAL DISCUSSION

### Report by the General Committee under Rule 42 of the Rules of Procedure

- 1. At its eighth meeting on 20 september 1960 the General Committee considred the provisional agenda for the current session,  $\frac{1}{2}$  as well as the list of supplementary items requested for inclusion in the agenda.  $\frac{2}{2}$
- 2. The Committee decided to recommend that all the items of the provisional agenda should be included in the agenda for the session. With regard to the supplementary items, the Committee decided to recommend that item A the Use of Funds Provided to Defray the Agency's Administrative and Operational Services Costs in 1960 under the United Nations Expanded Programme of Technical Assistance should also be included in the agenda. The Committee did not consider it necessary to make a recommendation regarding supplementary item B Studies on Radioactive waste Disposal into the Sea in view of the information relating to that item which the Director General had provided in document GC(IV)/109/Add. 2.
- 3. The Committee had before it a proposal made by Poland under Rule 15 of the Rules of Procedure for the inclusion in the agenda of the matter of the grant of consultative status with the Agency to the World Federation of Trade Unions, and decided to recommend the inclusion of this item in the agenda.
- 4. In so far as the allocation of agenda items for initial discussion is concerned, the Committee was in agreement with the suggestions made in documents GC(IV)/109 and GC(IV)/109/Add.l and decided to recommend to the General Conference that the items should be so allocated for initial discussion. It further decided to recommend that the matter of the grant of consultative status with the Agency to the World Federation of Trade Unions should be discussed at a plenary meeting held on or after 28 September 1960.

# The proposed inclusion in the agenda of the matter of the grant of consultative status with the Agency to the World Federation of Trade Unions

#### Explanatory memorandum by Poland

- 1. The Polish delegation is proposing the inclusion in the agenda of the General Conference of the matter of the grant of consultative status with the Agency to the World Federation of Trade Unions.
- 2. The Polish delegation is of the view that the matter is important and urgent. This is brought out, <u>inter alia</u>, by the fact that the General Conference at its third regular session adopted a resolution recommending the Board of Governors, in accordance with Article V.D. of the Statute, to reconsider the question of granting consultative status with the Agency to the World Federation of Trade Unions, and by the contents of the report by the Board of Governors in document GC(IV)/INF/29.
