APPLICATIONS FOR MEMBERSHIP OF THE AGENCY

Application by the Republic of the Ivory Coast

Recommendation by the Board of Governors

1. On 22 January 1963 the following letter addressed to the Director General by the President of the Republic of the Ivory Coast was communicated to the Board:

"8037/AE/SG" "19 December 1962

"I have the honour to request the International Atomic Energy Agency to accept the Republic of the Ivory Coast as a Member.

"In the name of the Government of the Republic of the Ivory Coast I wish to assure the Agency of the willingness of the Republic of the Ivory Coast to carry out the obligations of membership in the Agency in accordance with its Statute and with the purposes and principles of the Charter of the United Nations."

2. On 19 February the Board considered this application for membership of the Agency in the light of Article IV. B of the Statute, and determined that the Republic of the Ivory Coast was able and willing to act in accordance with the purposes and principles of the Charter of the United Nations. The Board accordingly recommends that the General Conference approve the Ivory Coast for membership of the Agency and submits the draft resolution below for the consideration of the General Conference.

APPLICATION BY THE REPUBLIC OF THE IVORY COAST FOR MEMBERSHIP OF THE AGENCY

The General Conference,

- (a) Having received the recommendation of the Board of Governors that the Republic of the Ivory Coast should be approved for membership of the Agency, [1] and
- (b) Having considered the Ivory Coast's application for membership in the light of Article IV. B of the Statute.

Approves the Republic of the Ivory Coast for membership of the Agency.
