SCALE OF MEMBERS' CONTRIBUTIONS FOR 1964

Memorandum by the Director General

1. The Director General submits herewith, for the consideration of the General Conference, a draft resolution containing the proposed scale of assessment for 1964.

2. In accordance with the recommendation made by the General Conference at its second regular session [1] this scale, like the one adopted by the Agency for 1963, is based on the United Nations scale for 1962, 1963 and 1964. Any reductions in the percentage assessments for 1964 as compared with the Agency's scale for 1963 are due to the inclusion in the scale of the five new Member States which have joined the Agency, namely Bolivia, Liberia, Saudi Arabia, the Syrian Arab Republic and Uruguay.

3. The proposed scale of assessment for 1964 is based on the Agency's membership on 31 August 1963. An explanation of the numerical data used in calculating the scale is given in the Annex to the present document. The procedure for calculating the contribution of any State that becomes a Member of the Agency after the scale for 1964 has been adopted is set out in the second paragraph of the draft resolution.

1. <u>Decides</u> that the scale for assessment of Members' contributions to the Agency's Regular Budget for the financial year 1964 shall be as follows:

Decides further that any State that becomes a Member of the Agency during the remainder of 1963 or in 1964 shall be assessed as appropriate for contributions to the Agency's Regular Budget for those years, and for its advance to the Working Capital Fund, by applying to its United Nations percentage the appropriate coefficient used to determine the scales for assessment of Members' contributions for 1963 and 1964.

B. Method for calculating the coefficient 0.923

1. In the United Nations scale for 1962, 1963 and 1964, the assessments of Members of the Agency that are also Members of the United Nations amount to 98.68% of the total. The assessments recommended by the United Nations for the Agency's Members that are not Members of the United Nations amount to 7.08%, making a grand total of 105.76% (see columns 2 and 3 of section A above).

2. It is therefore necessary to find a coefficient by which to multiply the abovementioned assessments of Members of the Agency so as to decrease the total to 100.00%. In calculating this coefficient the following considerations were taken into account:

- (a) The percentage contribution of the United States of America in the Agency's scale for 1963 was set at a maximum of 32.02. In accordance with the decision of the General Conference [2] the coefficient has not been applied to the United Nations percentage of the highest contributor. However, in the Agency's scale for 1964, its percentage has been reduced by applying to it a proportionate share in the percentages of new Members which have joined the Agency. This has resulted in a new percentage rate of 31.93 for the highest contributor without increasing the percentage of any other Member State; this figure still represents the highest rate of assessment of any Member on a per capita basis; and
- (b) The percentages of the following Member States are fixed at a minimum level of 0.04 in both the United Nations and the Agency's scales:
 - Albania Bolivia Cambodia El Salvador Haiti Holy See Honduras Iceland Liberia Mali Monaco Nicaragua Paraguay

giving a total of 0.52.

3. The coefficient has been calculated as follows:
