Memorandum by the Director General

- 1. By 6 p.m. on 29 September 46 Members of the Agency had pledged voluntary contributions to the General Fund for 1973 as shown in the table overleaf.
- 2. When the Conference takes up this item of its agenda, the President will invite its attention to the contributions to the General Fund for next year that have by then been pledged. In order to expedite matters, the delegates of those Members that have not yet made a pledge are invited to communicate their Governments' pledges as soon as possible.
