ADVANCE GENERAL INFORMATION

Airport reception at New Delhi and Bombay

1. The Host Government has arranged for special counters at New Delhi and Bombay airports to facilitate customs and immigration clearance for delegates to the Conference. All delegates are therefore asked to proceed to the "IAEA General Conference" counter after debarkation.

Reception by the Prime Minister of India

2. All delegates to the Conference will receive an invitation to attend a reception hosted by the Prime Minister of India on 4 December 1979 at about 5.30 p.m. The reception will be followed by a cultural programme of classical Indian dances.

Visit to Bhabha Atomic Research Centre, Bombay

3. The Host Government extends an invitation to the heads of all delegations or one of their nominees for a day's visit to the Bhabha Atomic Research Centre in Bombay on Saturday, 8 December 1979. A special chartered flight for the invitees will leave Delhi about 8 a.m. for Bombay and will return to Delhi on the same day by about 8 p.m. All delegations are requested to communicate the names of their representatives to the Information Desk at the Conference Centre on 4 December 1979 to facilitate the arrangements.

Sightseeing in Delhi

4. The Host Government is making arrangements for conducted sightseeing tours of the historic city of Delhi for all delegates in batches of 60 at specific times on particular days during the General Conference. All interested delegates are requested to give their names to the Information Desk.

International Trade Fair

5. An International Trade Fair will be taking place in Delhi at the time of the General Conference. A special pavilion exhibiting developments in the field of atomic energy in India, including several dynamic exhibits, is being set up at the Trade Fair. All delegates are invited to visit the atomic energy pavilion at prearranged times during the General Conference.
