CONSIDERATION OF THE SUSPENSION OF ISRAEL FROM THE EXERCISE OF THE PRIVILEGES AND RIGHTS OF MEMBERSHIP IF, BY THE TIME OF THE GENERAL CONFERENCE'S TWENTY-SIXTH REGULAR SESSION, IT HAS NOT COMPLIED WITH THE PROVISIONS OF UNITED NATIONS SECURITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION 487 OF 19 JUNE 1981

Draft resolution submitted jointly by Algeria, Bangladesh, Cuba, Indonesia, Iraq, Mali, Pakistan, Saudi Arabia, Syrian Arab Republic, Senegal, Tunisia and Zambia

## The General Conference,

- (a) <u>Having considered</u> the item entitled "Consideration of the suspension of Israel from the exercise of the privileges and rights of membership if, by the time of the General Conference's twenty sixth regular session, it has not complied with the provisions of United Nations Security Council resolution 487 of 19th June 1981",
- (b) Recalling the resolution adopted by the Board of Governors, on 12th June 1981 concerning the military attack on the Iraqi Nuclear Research Center and its implications for the Agency,
- (c) Taking note of General Assembly resolutions No. 36/25 and 36/27,
- (d) Recalling its resolution GC(XXV)/RES/381,
- (e) Expressing its deep concern over the refusal of Israel to implement that resolution,

- (f) <u>Deeply concerned</u> about Israel's escalation of aggression against other countries of the region and occupation and annexation of territories, particularly the occupation of Lebanon and the genocide perpetrated against the Palestinian people,
- (g) <u>Recarling</u> the provision of Article IV.b of the Statute of the Agency which states, inter-alia, that "In recommending and approving a State for membership, the Board of Governors and the General Conference shall determine that the State is able and willing to carry out the obligations of membership in the Agency, giving due consideration to its ability and willingness to act in accordance with the purposes and principles of the Charter of the United Nations.
- (h) Further taking note of the resolution adopted by the ninth Emergency Special Session of the General Assembly on 4th February 1982 (ES-9/1), which declared inter-alia, that Israel's record and actions confirm that it is not a peace-loving Member State and that it has carried out neither its obligations under the Charter nor its commitment under General Assembly resolution 273(III) of 11 May 1949,
- (i) Affirming the necessity to ensure against the repetition of such an attack on nuclear facilities by Israel,
  - 1. <u>Considers</u> the refusal of Israel to implement Security Council resolution No. 487 and resolution GC(XXV)/RES/381 of the Conference contrary to the principles of the United Nations Charter and a violation of the criteria for membership of States listed in the Statute of the Agency;
  - 2. <u>Decides</u> to suspend Israel from the exercise of the privileges and rights of membership for its persistent violation of the Statute and the purposes and principles of the Charter of the United Nations;

- 3. . Strongly condemns Israel for maintaining its threats to repeat such attacks in future;
- 4. <u>Calls</u> upon all Member States to initiate action for the adoption of a convention to prohibit armed attacks against nuclear facilities for peaceful purposes;
- 5. <u>Calls</u> upon all Members to release all information in their possession concerning the Israeli nuclear armament programme.
