The General Conference suspended for the twenty-seventh regular session the relevant part of Rule 40 of its Rules of Procedure to permit the election of six additional Members. It elected the delegates of Egypt, France, the German Democratic Republic, the Federal Republic of Germany, Iraq and Paraguay as additional members of the General Committee, and duly appointed the General Committee for the twenty-seventh regular session.
