MEASURES TO STRENGTHEN INTERNATIONAL CO-OPERATION IN NUCLEAR SAFETY AND RADIOLOGICAL PROTECTION

PROHIBITION OF ARMED ATTACKS ON ALL NUCLEAR INSTALLATIONS

Draft resolution submitted by Argentina and Mexico

The General Conference,

(a) <u>Recalling</u> IAEA General Conference resolution GC(XXIX)/RES/444, and in particular its operative paragraphs 3 and 4,

(b) <u>Aware of</u> the fact that an armed attack on a nuclear installation could result in radioactive releases with grave consequences within and beyond the boundaries of the State which has been attacked, and

(c) <u>Convinced of</u> the need to prohibit armed attacks on all nuclear installations and of the urgency of concluding an international agreement in this regard,

- 1. <u>Takes note</u> of the discussions in the Board on this matter;
- 2. <u>Requests</u> the Director General to initiate detailed technical studies on the possible radiological consequences of an armed attack on nuclear facilities;
- 3. <u>Appeals</u> to the Member States to provide information to the Agency relevant to such studies; and
- 4. <u>Further requests</u> the Director General to keep the Board and the General Conference informed about the progress in this regard.
