APPLICATION OF IAEA SAFEGUARDS IN THE MIDDLE EAST

Draft resolution submitted by Egypt, Kuwait, Lebanon, Qatar and the United Arab Emirates

The General Conference,

- (a) Recognizing the importance of non-proliferation of nuclear weapons both globally and regionally in enhancing international peace and security,
- (b) <u>Mindful</u> of the usefulness of the Agency's safeguards system as a reliable means of verification to ensure the promotion of peaceful uses of nuclear energy,
- (c) <u>Concerned</u> by the grave consequences endangering peace and security of the presence in the region of nuclear activities not wholly devoted to peaceful purposes,
- (d) <u>Welcoming</u> the recent initiatives on arms control in the region and on the establishment therein of a zone free of weapons of mass destruction, including nuclear weapons, and
- (e) <u>Taking note</u> of the efforts of the Agency concerning the application of Agency safeguards in the Middle East,
- 1. Affirms the urgent need for all States in the Middle East to forthwith accept the application of full-scope Agency safeguards to all their nuclear activities as an important confidence-building measure among all States in the region and as a step in enhancing peace and security;

- 2. Requests the Director General to take such measures as are necessary to ensure the early application of full-scope Agency safeguards to all nuclear activities in the Middle East, and in particular to prepare a model agreement with a view to accomplishing this objective;
- 3. <u>Calls upon</u> all States in the region to extend their fullest co-operation to the Director General in the fulfilment of the tasks entrusted to him in the preceding paragraph;
- 4. <u>Further calls upon</u> all other States, especially those with a special responsibility for the maintenance of international peace and security, to render all assistance to the Director General to facilitate the implementation of this resolution; and
- 5. Requests the Director General to submit to the Board of Governors and to the General Conference at its thirty-sixth regular session a report on the implementation of this resolution and to include in the provisional agenda for that session an item entitled "Application of IAEA safeguards in the Middle East".
