Provisional agenda

1. In accordance with Rule 2 of the Rules of Procedure of the General Conference¹, the Director General hereby notifies all members of the Agency that the fiftieth regular session of the General Conference will open at the <u>Austria Center Vienna</u>² on Monday, 18 September 2006 at <u>9.30 a.m.</u>

2. This year the Conference is starting earlier than usual because, as it is the 50th General Conference, there will be a special ceremonial opening. In addition to the message of the Secretary-General of the United Nations, the Federal President of the Republic of Austria will make a statement on behalf of the host country at the opening of the Conference.

3. During the weekend preceding the opening of the Conference's session (Saturday, 16 September and Sunday, 17 September 2006), facilities will be made available for group meetings. Member States are strongly urged to avail themselves of those facilities with a view to achieving early agreement on organizational matters by participating in pre-session group meetings and the associated group decision-making. Meeting rooms may be reserved through the Secretariat's Conference Service Section (tel. no.: +43 1 2600/21320).

4. Pursuant to Rule 11 of the Conference's Rules of Procedure, the Director General has drawn up the attached provisional agenda for the session in consultation with the Board of Governors. In the annotation to each item a suggestion is made, for consideration by the General Committee, as to where it should first be discussed - in plenary or in a committee.

5. Should the Director General receive by 18 August 2006 any request under Rule 13 for inclusion of a supplementary item in the agenda, such an item will, unless Rule 21 applies, be placed on a list which will be circulated not later than 28 August 2006.

Member States will be urged to pledge contributions to the Technical Cooperation Fund for 2007 and attention will be drawn to the fact that such pledges of contributions can be made during the session.

³ As stated in paragraph 3 of the cover note, facilities are being made available for area groups to meet during the weekend preceding the opening of the Conference's session. It is hoped that this measure will help area groups to reach agreement on their nominees for membership of the General Committee **before Monday morning** so that the work of the Conference can proceed without delay.

8. General debate and Annual Report for 2005

Under Article V.E.4 of the Statute, the Conference is required to consider the Agency's Annual Report for the year 2005, which the Board has approved (GC(50)/4).

As part of the efforts to streamline the work of the General Conference, it is recommended that statements by delegates in the general debate be limited to 15 minutes.

9. Election of members to the Board of Governors

The Conference will be called upon to elect 11 members to the Board⁴. Under Rule 83, the President will indicate to the Conference those elective places on the Board which must be filled so as to ensure that after the end of the session the Board will be constituted in accordance with Article VI.A of the Statute. Designations made in accordance with Article VI.A.1 of the Statute for membership on the Board in 2006-2007 are set out in document GC(50)/5.

10. The Agency's Accounts for 2005

In accordance with Rule 12(i), the Agency's Accounts for 2005, together with the External Auditor's report thereon and the report of the Board, are being communicated to the Conference.

11. The Agency's Budget for 2007

Under Article V.E.5 of the Statute, the Conference is called upon to approve the Agency's Budget for 2007 which the Board, pursuant to Article XIV.A, is submitting to it in document GC(50)/6.

12. Amendment to Article XIV.A of the Statute

By resolution GC(43)/RES/8 the General Conference approved an amendment to Article XIV.A of the Agency's Statute, permitting biennial budgeting. Recalling GC(49)/DEC/13, this item has been included in the agenda to enable the Conference to consider the issue of the entry into force of the amendment.

13. Scale of assessment of members' contributions towards the Regular Budget Committee of the Whole

Pursuant to Article XIV.D of the Statute, a proposed scale of assessment of members' contributions towards the Regular Budget for 2007 will be submitted to the Conference.

14. Measures to strengthen international cooperation in nuclear, *Committee of the Whole* radiation and transport safety and waste management

This item is included in the provisional agenda pursuant to resolutions GC(48)/RES/10 and GC(49)/RES/9. It is expected that the General Conference will have before it reports on a number of issues, including:

- development in items under GC(49)/RES/9.A and B; and
- the Nuclear Safety Review for the year 2005.

15. Nuclear security – measures to protect against nuclear terrorism

16. Strengthening of the Agency's technical cooperation activities *Committee of the Whole*

This item is included in the provisional agenda to enable the Director General to report on the implementation of resolution GC(49)/RES/11 as requested in its operative paragraph 20.

17. Strengthening the Agency's activities related to nuclear Committee of the Whole science, technology and applications

This item is included in the provisional agenda pursuant to resolutions GC(48)/RES/13 and GC(49)/RES/12. It is expected that the General Conference will have before it reports on a number of issues, including:

- development in items under GC(49)/RES/12.A;
- programme of action for cancer therapy;
- support to the African Union's Pan African Tsetse and Trypanosomosis Eradication Campaign (AU-PATTEC);
- innovative nuclear technology; _
- nuclear power infrastructure development;
- sterile insect technique for the control or eradication of malaria-transmitting mosquitoes; _
- nuclear knowledge management; and
- the Nuclear Technology Review 2006. _

18. Strengthening the effectiveness and improving the efficiency Committee of the Whole of the safeguards system and application of the Model **Additional Protocol**

This item is included in the provisional agenda pursuant to resolution GC(49)/RES/13 to enable the Director General to report on the implementation of the resolution as requested in its operative paragraph 24.

19. Implementation of the NPT safeguards agreement between **Plenary** the Agency and the Democratic People's Republic of Korea

This item is included in the provisional agenda pursuant to operative paragraph 6 of resolution GC(49)/RES/14, in which the General Conference decided last year to remain seized of this matter and to include this item in the agenda for its fiftieth regular session.

20. Application of IAEA safeguards in the Middle East

This item is included in the provisional agenda pursuant to resolution GC(49)/RES/15 adopted by the General Conference last year. The Director General will report to the Conference on the implementation of the resolution as requested in its operative paragraph 9.

21. Israeli nuclear capabilities and threat

This item has been included in the provisional agenda at the request of the Arab States that are members of the Agency, as forwarded by the Sultanate of Oman. An explanatory memorandum, required under Rule 20 of the Rules of Procedure of the General Conference, will be before the Conference.

The Conference is called upon to elect two representatives from Member States to serve on the Agency's Staff Pension Committee.

24. Examination of delegates' credentials

Under Rule 28 of the Rules of Procedure the General Committee, meeting as a credentials committee, will examine the credentials of all delegates and report thereon to the Conference.

25. Report on contributions pledged to the Technical Cooperation Plenary Fund for 2007

It is expected that pledges of contributions to the Technical Cooperation Fund for 2007 will be obtained during the Conference and that the President will communicate a report thereon to the Conference.
