Statement of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Croatia on the recent nuclear tests conducted by India

Croatia deeply regrets the deplorable decision of the Indian Government to conduct the tests. We are most concerned about the possible negative consequences of this action in regard to the regional and global stability and on the overall non-proliferation regime.

We strongly urge the Indian Government to join the vast majority of the States in their effort to curb the spread of nuclear arms and work for the world free of the nuclear threat.
