Verbal Note

The Permanent Mission of the Federal Republic of Germany to the Office of the United Nations and to the other International Organizations in Vienna presents its compliments to the Secretariat of the International Atomic Energy Agency and has the honour to attach the text of the statement delivered by the German Governor at the meeting of the IAEA Board of Governors on 8 June 2015 in connection with the Annual Report for 2014:

I fully support the remarks that were made by the distinguished representative of Latvia on behalf of the European Union, and I would like to make some additional remarks in a national capacity.

In reference to the statement made by the distinguished Governor of the Russian Federation and in aligning itself with interventions i.a. made by the distinguished Governors of the United States of America, of Australia and Canada, Germany would like to state the following:

Annexes 30a and 30b of the Annual Report for 2014 contained in document GOV/2015/27 are fully in line with resolution 68/262 of the General Assembly, adopted on 27 March 2014, which affirms in Operative Paragraph 1 the commitment of the General Assembly to the sovereignty, political independence, unity and territorial integrity of Ukraine within its internationally recognized borders.

Therefore, our position is: annexes 30a and 30b of the Annual Report concerning Ukraine should remain as they stand.

The Permanent Mission of the Federal Republic of Germany requests that this Note Verbale be circulated as an IAEA Information Circular.
