THE PROVISIONAL STAFF REGULATIONS OF THE AGENCY

Modifications

Since the Provisional Staff Regulations of the Agency were reproduced in document INFCIRC/6 for the information of all Members, the Board of Governors has made the following amendments to them:

(a) Regulation 5.01(b) to read:

(b) The base salaries of staff in the Professional and higher categories, which are related to the costs of living of such staff at Geneva, shall be adjusted according to the schedule of post adjustments set forth in Annex III as necessary from time to time to preserve equivalent standards of living at different offices. The post adjustment applicable to the salaries of staff serving at the Agency's headquarters shall be determined by the Board of Governors; determinations in respect of staff serving elsewhere shall be made by the Director General.

- (a) Staff members in the Professional and higher categories shall be entitled to receive dependency allowances as follows:
 - (i) At US \$400 per annum for a dependent wife or dependent husband and at US \$300 per annum for each dependent child; or

Such payment shall be equivalent to an additional step increment and may extend beyond the maximum salary of the grade of the staff member concerned.
