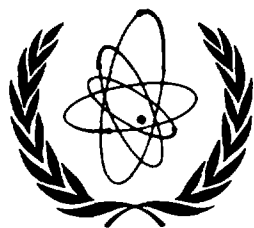

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**THE PROVISIONAL STAFF REGULATIONS OF THE AGENCY**

**Amendments to Annexes II and III**

On 8 June 1971 the Board of Governors made amendments to Annexes II and III to the Provisional Staff Regulations which superseded the earlier amendments to those Annexes set forth in document INFCIRC/6/Rev.2/Mod.1. Paragraphs 2-4 of that document are accordingly modified as follows:
