## THE CLASSIFICATION OF DOCUMENTS

## INTRODUCING CHANGES IN OTHER DOCUMENTS

- 1. A document that is issued for the purpose of making a change in the form or content of an earlier document is at present classified in one of three ways. It may be issued as a corrigendum to correct a mistake in the earlier document[1], an addendum to supplement the information given[2] or a revision to make such extensive changes as warrant re-issue of the whole document[3].
- 2. However, none of these three classifications covers the case where it is desirable to modify the earlier documents by revising only part of it. Such modifications will therefore be identified in future by the suffix "Mod.", thus INFCIRC/....Mod.1.
