The Permanent Mission of the Russian Federation to the International Organizations in Vienna presents its compliments to the Secretariat of the International Atomic Energy Agency and has the honour to transmit the following.

Ukraine continues performing provocative acts aimed at creating threats to nuclear facilities on its own territory. At the same time, the Ukrainian side is spreading disinformation that it is allegedly Russia that is endangering these facilities during the special military operation. But the facts are just the opposite.

On July 18, the armed forces of Ukraine, using two unmanned aerial vehicles, attacked the territory of the Zaporozhskaya Nuclear Power Plant (ZNPP). One of them was shot down while approaching the station. Another loitering drone hit in the immediate vicinity (several tens of meters) from the facilities critical for the safety of the nuclear power plant - the storage of spent nuclear fuel and the reactor cooling tank. As a result, the Russian military guarding the ZNPP got injured.

This loitering drone attack against the ZNPP zone is a blatant case. Ukraine, using such weapons near a nuclear facility, creates a threat not only to its own, but to the entire territory of Europe. Responsibility for the possible grave consequences of the behavior of the Kiev authorities lies not only on them, but also on the states that provide military support to the criminal regime of V. Zelensky. Those responsible for this and other similar crimes should be subject to punishment.
