I'm writing to you to submit, pursuant to Rule 63 of the Rules of Procedure of the General Conference, China's amendment to the GC's draft resolution on Regular Budget Appropriations for 2023, at the sixty-sixth (2022) session of the General Conference of the International Atomic Energy Agency scheduled to be held from 26 September. Amendment by China to the GC's Draft Resolution on Regular Budget Appropriations for 2023

I. Reformulate the first preambular paragraph as follows:

"<u>Accepting</u> the recommendations of the Board of Governors relating to the Regular Budget of the Agency for 2023, <u>while reaffirming</u>, in this context, the relevance of Article II of the Statute,"

II. Add the following two paragraphs at the end of the operative part:

"<u>Decides</u> that, in accordance with the objectives of the Statute, none of the Agency's budget shall be used in such a way as to further any military purpose,"

"<u>Requests</u> regular reports to be submitted, by the Secretariat, to the General Conference, so as to ensure that the Agency's budget is not used in any way to further any military purpose, in consistent with Articles II and XII of the Agency's Statute."
