

SAFEGUARDS AGREEMENT WITH AUSTRALIA

During the 10th session of the General Conference, Australia became the 25th country to accept Agency safeguards control. Under an agreement with the USA and the Agency, controls will be exercised over nuclear facilities and material provided under a cooperation agreement between Australia and the USA to ensure that they will be used only for peaceful purposes.
