Taylor Wilson is a nuclear physicist from the United States. In 2009, at age 14, he became the youngest person in history to work with nuclear fusion, and after that developed several innovations in the area of nuclear energy. He is the recipient of many prestigious awards, including the Thiel Fellowship and the Intel Foundation Young Scientist Award.
